

COMPUTER CLUB DISCUSSION GROUP

SAVE AND PRINT WEBPAGE PHOTOS (Follow carefully)

This procedure covers any picture saved to your directory including ones you may receive as email attachments, which appear large, and you are unable to print a viewable picture.

1. Select, open a picture, Right click (RC) on the picture, Left Click (LC) SAVE AS, and save it in a folder of your choice (Just remember where you save it).
2. To print it, make sure your printer is set to landscape.
3. Open Directory and highlight picture you wish to print, LC on PRINT THIS PICTURE/FILE.
4. LC NEXT, verify your picture is selected, LC NEXT and verify the correct printer is selected - LC NEXT.
5. Make sure the glossy paper is loaded in your printer.
6. I recommend selecting the second option for a full-page print. LC next when you have selected the desired option.

PRINT A LARGE SIZE PICTURE FROM WALLBOARD PANEL

1. Open IRFANVIEW software LC FILE and open selected Wallboard Panel. For downloading IrfanView Click on last Link on the 2004 Computer Club webpage and LC RUN which will install and open the program.
2. Open HR Wallboard panel and using scroll bars, position desired photo on Wallboard Panel in center of screen, position cursor in upper left corner of picture and while depressing and holding the LC mouse button select the full width and approximately 3/4 down on the picture. Release the LC mouse button.
3. Depress and hold the CTRL Key, depress and release the Y Key, and release the CTRL Key. Your picture should now be cropped.
4. LC FILE, SAVE AS, annotate file name with "crpd", select directory you want to save file in, and LC SAVE. Make sure the glossy paper is loaded in your printer.
5. Open above Directory and highlight picture you wish to print, LC on PRINT THIS PICTURE/FILE.
6. LC NEXT, verify your picture is selected, LC NEXT, verify the correct printer is selected, and LC NEXT.

TRACE, CUT AND PASTE ON BACKGROUND WITH “GIMP” PHOTO SOFTWARE

**You Must have the GIMP software installed per previous Computer Club meetings.
Refer to the Computer Club webpage for download information.**

- 1. Open GIMP, LC File, and LC Open, select and highlight desired file and LC Open.**
- 2. LC Tools, place cursor on Selection Tools, move cursor to Intelligent Scissors and LC once.**
- 3. Increase size of picture to make tracing easier by LC'ing the down arrow at bottom left of screen and selecting a different setting.**
- 4. Pick a starting point on the image you wish to select and LC, which will place a visible dot at that point.**
- 5. Move the pointed end of the cursor to next point and LC. To increase definition of selection, place the pointer at obvious junctions or dramatic changes in flow pattern.**
- 6. When the ending and starting points are joined, LC once, inside selected area, to complete the selection process.**
- 7. LC Edit, LC Copy, LC File, LC New LC on the Advanced plus sign and select Transparency from the Fill With window.**
- 8. A new Untitled window will open at the approximate size of the selection. LC Edit, in the new window, then LC paste. This will place the selection in its own window.**
- 9. Open the desired new background picture on which you want to place the selection LC Edit, LC paste and observe selection appears on background.**
- 10. Save newly created picture with new name in your directory.**
