Here are some of the highlights of park activities for the remaining month of November.

Saturday Nov 19 8:00 AM Saturday morning breakfast begins this week in the Rec Hall with a limited menu. Two pancakes, two sausage patties, Coffee, and juice all for \$2.50pp. Sign-up is required to insure sufficient food is available.

Tuesday Nov 22 7:00 PM Our weekly Bingo began last week. Cards are \$1.00 ea or six for \$5.00. ALL of the card sales money is returned in prize money. We also give Door prizes and hot buttered popcorn to our players.

Monday Nov 21 11:15 AM Bible Group begins their weekly sessions this week. These sessions are opened to anyone interested in attending.

Thursday Nov 24 1:30 PM Thanksgiving Day Dinner. Please sign-up and indicate what type covered dish or desert you are bringing. Cost is \$3.00pp to offset cost of turkey, stuffing, gravy and beverages.

Friday Nov 25 11:30 AM Leftover Lunch. Be advised the calendar has a 12:00 start time, which is now 11:30. Cost is \$2.00pp. Signup not required – first come first serve. Please make the time change on your calendar copy.

Try to attend our weekly Monday morning park meetings. You not only get the latest information on park activities but you have the opportunity to socialize with other park guests. ALL park residents are cordially invited to attend our various activities and outside the park events.

We are in need of volunteers for all of our activities. Volunteer signup sheets, for December Ice Cream Social and Bingo, are up on the Rec Hall bulletin board for your review. We ideally would like to be able to set up a schedule, and depending on the number of volunteers, you would need only to volunteer once a month or less. We need your help.

Comcast will be modifying our current cable service sometime in February. At that time the service will be limited to approximately 17 channels. Starting now, Comcast will supply up to three (3) DTA Adapters per household, which will enable reception of a higher number of channels plus enhanced quality. The three DTA Adapters are free of charge. Several folks in the park have already obtained and installed the adapters with remarkable results.

Those wishing to enhance their current cable service are able to obtain optional Comcast HD/DVR boxes as well as Internet service. ALL TVs, not connected to a Comcast Digital box, and hooked directly to the Comcast cable connector at each site, will require the free DTA Adapters after February. Comcast is located at 13040 Livingstone Rd Suite 11. Phone 239.653.9640. They open at 8:00 AM. Probably a good idea to get the boxes now. This is a nationwide conversion not just in the Naples area.
