We are in our third week under new ownership and our Resort Manager Diana Bland and her staff could not be more pleased with the response, onsite support and professionalism exhibited by Sun Communities management during the transition from Morgan.

The bug that has plagued the park over the past few weeks has claimed Lynn Gilles as its latest victim. In order to minimize proliferation of any virus or bug, avoid hugging and kissing when greeting new arrivals, at least for the time being. Do use hand sanitizer or wash hands frequently.

We have received complaints from park residents concerning dog walking. Here are the guidelines for walking your pets. Walk pets on paved street only or, on the grassy area on the north side of the park, adjacent to the hospital property from the Bocce Court down to the fenced in area at the rear of the park. Please keep your pets from wandering on other guest sites. Some pets were observed peeing on guests shrubbery, stone work, and flower beds. We have a fenced in area at the rear of the park where you may let your pets run free. HOWEVER, some folks are of the opinion, since pets can run free, picking up poop after your pet is not required. People who use and maintain the storage area walk all over this area and do not wish to step in any animal poop. Management wants to assure you that picking up after your pets, in the fenced area is required and if this request continues to be ignored, the fenced in area will be locked from further use.

The need for volunteers for the various park activities continues. Volunteer signup sheets, for the next few months of our season for Ice Cream Social and Bingo, are up on the Rec Hall bulletin board for your review.
